Important Information Concerning The Repair of Your Vehicle

- Always take photographs of your vehicle before any repairs are made.
- Your insurance company cannot require you to go to a particular repair facility. You have the right to decide where you want your car repaired.
- Always ask if the repair facility has a warranty covering repairs, and ask for the length of the warranty.
- Always ask if your car will be repaired using manufacturer replacement parts. Often times, generic parts will be substituted, and you may never know.
- Make certain the repair facility has "unibody repair equipment."
- Make certain the repair facility has certified technicians.
- Even if your insurance company provides an estimate, I strongly recommend that you obtain an independent estimate from a repair facility of your choice.
- 8. Often times the insurance company will request that you visit their drive-in claims facility. You can voluntarily choose to do so, or you can take your vehicle to a repair facility of your choice, and request the insurance company to examine the vehicle at that location.
